## WALK DISTANCE: 1.9 MILES

Buile Hill was opened in 1903 and in 2001 the park was listed as a Grade 2 designated park. Today the park covers 68 acres and includes Buile Hill, Seedley Park, Springfield Villa and Hart Hill estate.

**DO YOU KNOW WHEN THE SENSORY GARDEN WAS FIRST OPENED?**

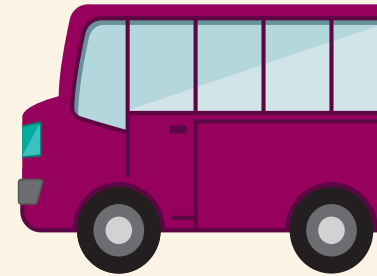
The sensory garden first opened in 1963.
