This newsletter is one way we will keep you informed about progress and opportunities to get involved.

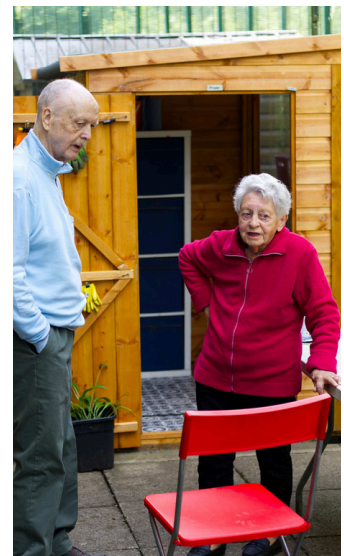
Celebrating 10 Years of Green and Grow: Avril
